



Princeton University Housing Information

Princeton University offers assistance and resources to incoming postdocs in support of finding accommodations.

The PU housing website, www.princeton.edu/facilities/housing, serves as a primary source for all relevant information.

The university's off-campus housing site, <http://offcampushousing.princeton.edu/> contains a list of university recommended local real estate agents as well as a listing of currently available rental units by local landlords and owners.

Private rentals and sublets can also be found on <http://ttrade.tigerapps.org>. This site for the Princeton University community is also a good resource for furniture, small kitchen appliances, and other items for sale close to campus.

The PU housing office for faculty and staff serves as a great reference for housing on campus, fshsg@princeton.edu, 609-258-3460. (For short term housing from 1 month to 1 year, check on vacancies for Olden House (studio and one bedroom.) For long term housing, check on vacancies at Merwick Stanworth (which provide apartments and townhouses.)

\$1,475 - \$2,200. Temporary housing for visiting faculty. 30 day minimum, 12 month max. The units are one bedroom or studio style apartments.

Merwick Stanworth - <http://www.merwickstanworthpu.com/>
\$1,425 - \$2,850. Housing for faculty and staff. One to three bedroom flats and townhomes. Please be aware the first phase opened in August 2014 so there is ongoing construction in the area.

Other options:

- Another option is the website called <https://www.airbnb.com>. Here, local residents host a room and facilities at their home at much cheaper prices, and might be a good option for a temporary lodging instead of a costly hotel. Also, the website screens all members prior to letting them join, and the services are pretty safe and reliable.

- The site <https://www.padmapper.com/> pulls from rent.com, craigslist, and a bunch of other sources, and puts them all conveniently on a map.

- Lakeview Terrace Complex is an option for one year rentals The contact is Jason Bilanin - work: 732-930-5000 and cell: 732-320-0092.
- Sonesta Suites (for short term)- Check out the suites by clicking the link below. Our contract is \$95 per night. It is tax exempt and you only pay the 3% occupancy tax. They come with a little kitchen and living area and there is a dining room that provides a full breakfast daily and a reception on Tuesday and Thursday with adult beverages and a light dinner. If the visitor is staying a month, they will sometimes discount the rate to \$65. Per day.
